Placing a sealant around the occlusal margins of your completed restoration will help prevent microleakage and post-operative sensitivity. In addition, a smooth shiny restoration will be the result of using a post-operative sealant. The use of topical and local anesthesia will be illustrated, giving various tips on how to give less painful injections.
